Dear Brothers in Christ,

It is with heavy hearts that we send this letter addressing the recent formation of Restoration Christian Church in Ghana, Africa.

It seems clear that Restoration Christian Church is committed to moving forward in its expressed intention of forming a new organizational structure for the independent Christian Churches of your country as outlined in its constitution. Because this structure stands in opposition to New Testament polity and to the principles of the Restoration Movement and after much prayer and discussion, the following motion was made:

We, the board of directors of Ghana Christian Mission, Training Tomorrow's Leaders and Ivory Coast Christian Mission do hereby withdraw partnership with Restoration Christian Church and all those who are members thereof effective August 4, 2016.

This decision was unanimous among the undersigned.

Please be assured this decision was not arrived at easily nor thoughtlessly, but only with great concern regarding the kingdom of God and the precedents for church organization as outlined in the New Testament.

We have no ill will toward those involved in Restoration Christian Church and, above all, desire that the gospel of Jesus Christ will continue to be faithfully announced throughout Ghana and the world.
