One lady said her whole household now believes in Jesus because she practiced Christian submission as taught in the Scriptures. Another lady said if she had this seminar earlier in her life she would not have divorced her husband.

Another lady confessed that she planned to hurt her husband, but she repented and promised to live peacefully with her husband.

Strong marriages make the church stronger and make the witness for Christ stronger in any community. We thank God for this ministry of the Christian Leadership Training Institute in Ghana.

NIGERIA UPDATE:

The government recently withdrew its subsidy on fuel cost. Nigerian economy is based mostly on the sale of its high-grade crude oil on the international market. One way to share this income with the citizens has been to subsidize the price of fuel within the nation. The loss of this subsidy is putting further economic strain on the ordinary Nigerian citizen.

The churches, their leaders and the followers of Jesus continue to stand strong in the promises of God as they face increasing hardships. Leadership development through Cross River Christian Bible College's two training centers and through the T.E.E. extension classes continue. The Faith-Way school is in full operation and doing well. The building for the new medical clinic in the suburb of Calabar is still waiting for inspection from the agency that will issue its license to operate.

The floor of the second level of the building will soon be poured. Workers are preparing the steel and wood framework to hold the concrete and rebar until it is well cured and the supports can be removed. After this, finish work can begin on the first level where the family of the Supervisor of Extension classes will live.
